

UKPRP Funders Executive Group (FEG)

Terms of Reference

The FEG will:

- Agree the overall strategic direction of the initiative.
- Decide the final portfolio of awards based on the Expert Review Group's (ERG) funding recommendations.
- Decide the final balance of the UKPRP portfolio, based on advice from the Scientific Advisory Board/ERG.
- Oversee implementation of the agreed monitoring and evaluation framework.
- Identify new opportunities and challenges in prevention research to be addressed by the partnership and promote cross consortia/network working to further the objectives of UKPRP.
- Review documentation relevant to funding such as call documents and guidance for working with industry.
- Identify measures that contribute to the sustainability of UKPRP investments.
- Provide a reference point for UKPRP within individual funder organisations and share intelligence of new funder-led initiatives that are relevant to UKPRP and prevention research more generally.
- Keep the UKPRP governance arrangements under review and ensure they remain fit for purpose.
- Be responsible for funder coordination and swift, efficient working.
- Maintain oversight of the UKPRP risk register.

Reporting responsibility

None. However, if individual funders have responsibilities to report to and from their own organisations, they should do this in a timely manner for the FEG to be effective. The FEG should aim to approve Expert Review Group recommendations within one week of the panel meeting.

Membership

FEG membership represents the core funding partners for the initiative.

Meetings

The FEG will meet at least twice a year to approve calls and awards; outside of these meetings there will regular exchange of information between the FEG members.
